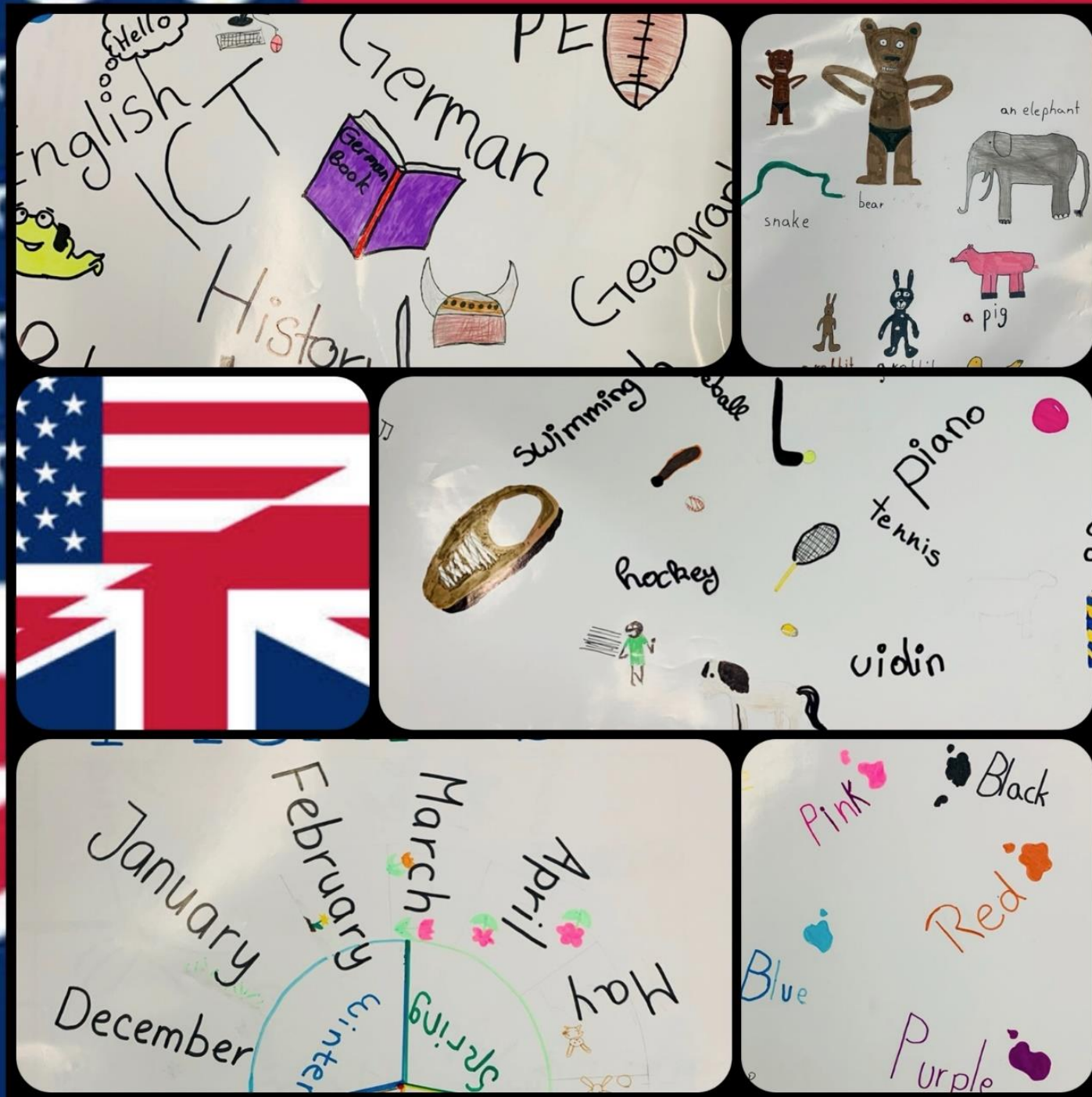




Challenges before construction starts

- John wanted to build a suspension bridge, but the city administration of New York didn't react.
- He was able to inspire a businessman and newspaper publisher with his idea. After a long time, the businessman was able to achieve a law of the state which allowed that a private company could build the Brooklyn Bridge.
- In 1867 the New York Bridge Company was founded.
- In 1869 Roebling's plans were approved and he became chief engineer.

The Engineers

The original engineer was John August Roebling (*1806 Mulhausen, Thüringen, Germany; † 1882 New York City, USA from blood poisoning). He was a world famous bridge builder and owner of a refinery.

His son Washington August Roebling took over the project of the Brooklyn Bridge (*1837 Pennsylvania, USA; † 1926).

The Construction

In 1867 construction started.

During construction several workers got ill and died.

Washington also got serious ill but survived. His wife Emily took over and managed big parts of construction. Because he was too injured John's son helped him.

THE STATUE OF LIBERTY



It's a figure of Libertas
↳ A roman Liberty goddess

She is holding a torch above her head with her right hand and in her left hand she is carrying a tablet inscribed in Roman numerals with "JULY IV MDCCLXXVI"

↳ (July 4, 1776)

↳ Date of the U.S. Declaration of Independence

The Statue of Liberty was a gift from the people of France to the people of the US

Dedicated: October 28, 1886

Its metal frame work was built by Gustave Eiffel.

FACTS

total weight: 225 tons

total height: 305 feet, 6 inches


the torch is covered with thin sheets of 24k gold

When the statue first arrived from France, she was the color of a shiny new penny.


↳ It took 20 years for Liberty to be the greenish-blue hue she is today.

there are 25 windows in the crown

↳ symbolic questions found on the torch
